

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. May I sign up for one week of a two-week camp and only pay for one week?

You may sign up for one week of a two-week camp if the price is listed by the week. You may not sign up for only one week of any camp for which the price is listed by two-week session only. It is difficult for us to fill the remaining week created by this scenario. However, you are welcome to call us two weeks before the class is scheduled to start, and we will consider your request on a space-availability basis.

2. My child can only attend camp on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. Will you adjust the price of the camp?

We are not able to adjust the price of a camp for part-time attendance. It is difficult for us to fill the remaining days created by this scenario. We feel strongly about consistent relationships within each group.

3. I need full-day care. If I sign up for a morning class, what are my options for the afternoon?

You may sign up for an afternoon class to complement the morning class you've chosen. We have tried to offer afternoon options for each age group. Half-Day Camp Minnehaha (page 3) is a good option to consider. We also have Extended Day care (page 4). Please give us a call if you'd like to discuss available options (612-728-7745).

4. My student is involved in camps at both campuses. Do I need to transport him between campuses?

No. We provide bus transportation between the South Campus and North Campus at the beginning of the day, at lunchtime, and at the end of the day. A supervised lunch period will take place at both the North and South Campuses. Students should bring a sack lunch. If your child is in PM Extended Day, you should pick him/her up at the South Campus; otherwise, you should plan to pick up your child at the location of his/her afternoon camp (unless you notify the teacher or Summer Programs office with other arrangements).

5. What if I need to cancel enrollment prior to the camp/course start date?

Please send us your schedule change in writing, or e-mail it to dunnstephanie@minnehahaacademy.net. A full refund, minus the \$50 deposit, will be given for camps/classes cancelled before May 15, 2012. After May 15, 2012, you will be responsible for paying the full summer tuition amount for the classes you chose for your student(s). If you are registering after May 15, 2012, please see our Refund Policy on page 30.

6. I don't know whether or not I will need Extended Day Camp. Can I sign up for Extended Day at a later time?

Yes, you may add Extended Day to your student's registration at a later date. Additionally, if your schedule changes and you need to use Extended Day unexpectedly, please contact our office and we will check on space availability.

7. Will classes and camps be held Wednesday, July 4?

No. All of our programs, including Camp Minnehaha, will be closed that day.

8. Are changes ever made after the catalog is printed?

Yes. Although we make every effort to print an accurate and complete catalog, changes do occur between the catalog print date in the winter and the beginning of the Summer Programs. 9. **Can my child attend Minnehaha Academy Summer Programs if he goes to a different school?**
Yes! Many students who participate in MA Summer Programs attend other schools during the academic year. We value the variety of students and families we get to know during the summer. Kindergarten-Bound and the SOAR classes are intended for students who attend Minnehaha Academy during the academic year, but all the other classes and camps are open to students from other schools.
10. **How is Minnehaha Academy's mission of integrating faith and learning expressed in the Summer Programs?**
Each class or camp will be taught from a Christian perspective and will have a faith component. This will be different in each class or camp, depending on the subject matter and teacher, but will often include daily devotions and prayer. Our students, during the academic year as well as during the summer, come from a variety of different faith backgrounds. We do not discriminate in our admission policy for the Summer Programs on the basis of gender, race, ethnic origin, or faith.
