Camp Particulars

Introduction to Shakespeare - Students will learn to understand Shakespeare's use of language and communicate the story to an audience. Process includes: watching Shakespeare film/play clips to evaluate performances and learn techniques, along with rehearsing and performing scenes from a Shakespearean comedy and tragedy. Students will also perform individual monologues. This class is highly recommended for students interested in the intensive "A Midsummer Night's Dream" Shakespeare Camp.

A Midsummer Night's Dream - Students will perform in a production of "A Midsummer Night's Dream", and receive individualized help with character creation and scene work. Students will learn to interpret Shakespeare's language and convey the meaning to an audience, along with participation in vocal/movement warm ups and exercises. Other skills include: learn rudimentary stage combat skills needed in the production, and also helping with creating the technical aspects of putting on a production (costumes, props, set, etc.).
