Permission slip and fees are due into the South Campus office (attn: Betsy Norby) by 12:00 noon on the Thursday before ski day. The permission slip is now on-line and must be signed for each trip. Trips will be canceled by 3:00 p.m. on the Thursday before ski day if there are not enough sign-ups to cover the costs. Trips will be canceled by noon on ski days due to weather.

The stage, will be made available at South Campus to store equipment on ski days. Students should bring equipment there right away in the morning. Students will also leave backpacks in this room during Ski Club and pick them up when they return from skiing.

CANCELLATION POLICY

A full refund will be given if Minnehaha cancels skiing due to weather or lack of participants or if student cancels **before 12pm** on the scheduled ski date.

The bus will load at South Campus at 3:30pm. The bus will load at Afton at 9:30pm and return to South Campus by 10:15pm. Please be waiting for your student(s) at M.A. by 10:15 pm.

RULES AND REGULATIONS for PARTICIPATION
